LOWELLVILLE SCHOOL FOUNDATION

The **Lowellville School Foundation** was established by the Board of Education in 2005 for the purpose of providing Lowellville graduates with scholarships and to provide educational resources for curriculum enrichment. The **Foundation** functions as a separate fund within the family of funds governed by the Lowellville Board of Education. However, the **Foundation** has a separate Board of Directors comprised of two Board of Education members, the Superintendent, the Treasurer, and five community members. These nine individuals have met on a regular basis during the past year to establish the by-laws for the **Foundation**, to establish the scholarship criteria, and to plan and execute a mail campaign to solicit donations from Lowellville alumni and Lowellville school district residents.

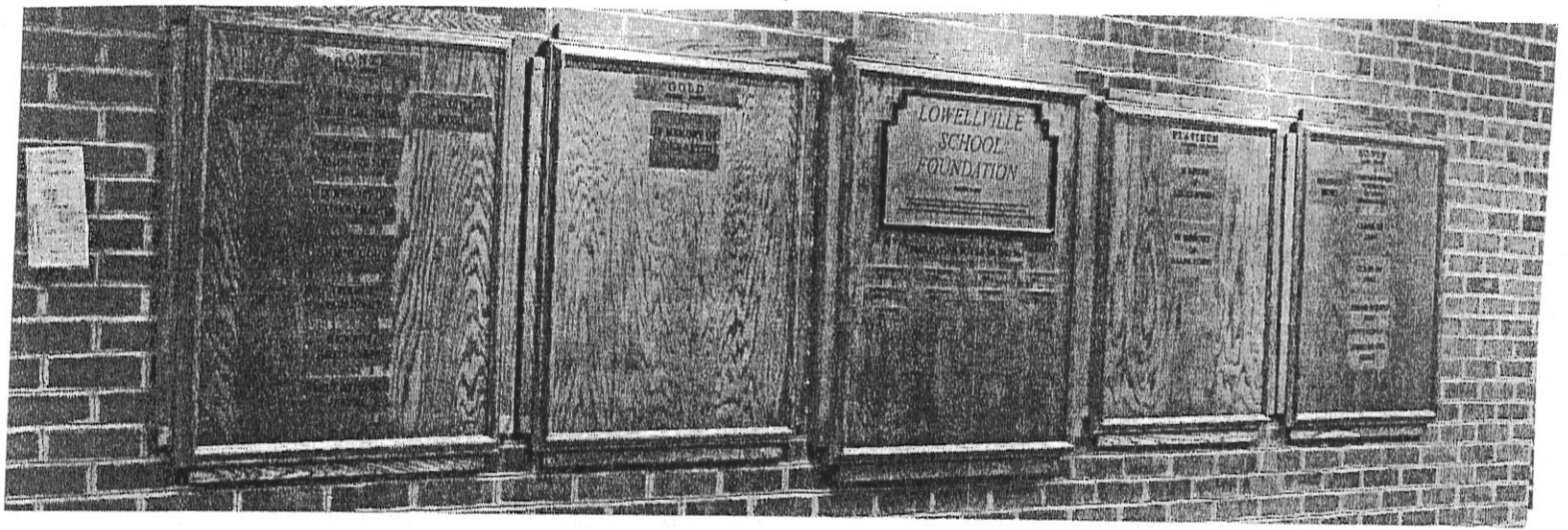
