

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SUMMER SWIM LESSONS CANCELLED FOR SUMMER 2023

Summer Swim lessons will not be offered summer 2023 due to major road construction on Fish Point Rd SE. There will be no access to the pools at Twin Oaks or Hidden Oaks Middle School. We will be back summer of 2024.

Driver Education (Ages 14.5-18)

Classroom: Students age 14.5+ can start Driver Education classes. Upon completion of the 30 hours of classroom, student will receive a Blue Completion Card.

Classroom Fee: \$220 payable to ISD 719

Permit Test: After completing classroom requirement of 30 hours and age 15+, students can test for permit at a DMV testing station.

Behind the Wheel: After receiving a permit, students schedule three 2-hours Behind-the-Wheel lessons with A+ Driving School (ISD719 classroom provider) or another provider.

Driver's License: Students age 16+ with a permit for a minimum of 6 months, completed Behind the Wheel Lessons, and Supervised Driving Log can test for a license at a testing station.

Supervised Driving Log:

- Option A: Student logs 50 hours/3,000 minutes including 15 hours/900 minutes night driving.
- Option B: Parent(s)/Guardian(s) attend Point of Impact class then student logs 40 hours/2,400 minutes including 15 hours/900 minutes night driving.
