

Student Health Advisory Council meeting minutes – February 9, 2023

1. Introduction and welcome of attendees

April Hooper-Christenson called the SHAC meeting to order on Feb 9, 2023 at the ESDC Building B Texas room at 7:09 pm with quorum met and secretary in attendance. Catherine Carlin was appointed Parliamentarian. Other visitors and guests are listed at the end of the minutes.

Mr. Moersch, CFBISD Interim Superintendent made some opening remarks. He asked for a moment of silence for the three students that have died. CFBISD school board members regret not being able to attend due to Superintendent interviews going on. He introduced the following guests: Chief Arredondo, Carrollton Police Chief, Chief Thomson, Carrollton Fire Chief, Mr. Babick, City of Carrollton Mayor, and Mr. Redden, Carrollton Executive Director of Public Safety. Mr. Moersch thanked the Carrollton Police for their efforts in keeping drug dealers off the streets, as well as Principals, counselors and school staff for their efforts in keeping students safe. He listed three options for the audience to share their perspective: participating in audience for guests, submitting a question on an index card at the back of the room to be added to the frequently asked questions on the CFB website, or sharing your perspective with a staff member in the hall outside this room after the fentanyl presentation.

April welcomed everyone, and reminded attendees to sign-in. Printed agenda and minutes of the previous meeting were available for attendees to pick up.

2. Review of Mission, Vision and Purpose of SHAC

Mission, vision and purpose of SHAC were stated.

3. Approve minutes from last meeting – October 10, 2022

The minutes from the October 10, 2022 SHAC meeting were approved with no corrections by general consent.

4. Audience for Guests

April invited guests who wish to speak to fill and submit an audience for guest form to the secretary.

5. SHAC Members

April asked the SHAC members to stand and reminded the audience that only appointed members can vote. The following people participated in Audience for guests: Debbie Petersen, Christina Pena, Cristina Barbe, Terry Thornton, Vivek Rao, Laurie Spindler, Stave Babick, Nau Rodriguez, Adolph Alvarez, and Laura Gallegos.

6. Presentation on the topic of fentanyl: Officer Stefanovic, School Resource Officer; Jo Gillen, Chief of SEL & Post-Secondary Readiness; Heather Hayes RN registered nurse at Turner high school and Sandra Lieck, Director of Health Services; Lance Hamlin, Assistant Superintendent.

Officer Stefanovic explained the role of a School Resource Officer and observations about fentanyl use in our community and schools: first confirmed incident in Carrollton in July of 2022 and in CFBISD in October of 2022. Following the October incident all CFBISD schools were equipped with Narcan, that they have not had to use to date. CFBISD hosted two drug Awareness meetings for parents in November 2022 at Creekview and Turner high schools. He talked about the importance for parents to talk to their children and to be very vigilant with their students' electronics.

Chief Arredondo said the Carrollton Police Department, is working with federal and local agencies as well as the City of Carrollton and CFBISD to confront the fentanyl crisis. There are not enough officers to be everywhere all the time, so they need help from the community to take drugs off the streets.

Ms. Gillen presented on what fentanyl is, its effects, withdrawal symptoms and what they are covering in the presentations that the Chemical Dependency Counselors are doing at all the middle and high schools for all students grades 6 through 12.

Nurse Hays and Ms. Lieck talked about the role of the school nurse and tips for parents on how they can tell if this child is using drugs and how they can get them tested. They also explained how Narcan works and provided links to resources for parents.

Mr. Hamlin talked about different partnerships that CFB has with agencies that support students, staff that support students with drug use awareness, information provided to students and ways for students and parents to report suspicion about drug use by a student.

Ms. Williams, School Counseling coordinator responded to questions from SHAC members by explaining how Counselors are required to work at least 80% of the time in Counseling duties and how this can help with drug use prevention. She also explained how campuses can organize their own drug prevention lessons and activities during Red Ribbon week.

The meeting was paused at 8:24pm to allow for the audience to leave if they wished to do so. The meeting restarted at 8:36pm.

7. Old Business

There was no old business.

8. New Business - SHAC Committee recommendations on curriculum subject to opt-in provisions of SB9

The SB9 legislation now requires that prevention of child abuse, family violence, dating violence and sex trafficking curriculum be opt-in and that SHAC to approve the curriculum and make recommendations to the school board. At the last meeting on Oct. 20, 2022 the following committee was appointed for this purpose: Jonathan Wilk, Kathy Riojas, Victoria Whitley, Betsy McKinney, April Hooper-Christenson, and Sylvia Mazuera

The committee would like to continue to review the curriculum options for the high school courses "Human Growth and Development" and "Counseling and Mental Health Services" and submit the recommendation to SHAC in the next couple of weeks at a virtual meeting.

Victoria Whitley on behalf of the committee, moved that SHAC approve the following curriculum to be presented to the school board for their approval:

- Texas School Procedures (TSP) Guidance Lessons
- CFBISD-created Guidance Lessons for Elementary students
- Nest Foundation High School Health Curriculum

After a vote the motion carried.

9. Questions/Discussion

Today's meeting was recorded and will be placed on the district website for everyone to have access to the presentation. April reminded everyone that the next SHAC meeting will take place on Apr 20, 2023 at 7pm and planning is underway for the speakers based on topics brought forward earlier this school year. There will be a special virtual meeting called in the next few weeks to approve the rest of the SB9 curriculum.

10. Adjourn

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:56pm
