



The Carney Lansford Award is given to an Outstanding Senior Male Athlete. They must have a minimum of a 3.25 grade point average, competed in at least 1 Varsity sport their senior year, and attended Wilcox for at least 2 years.

Carney Graduated from Wilcox in 1975, signing a professional contract with the California Angels. A few years later he was traded to the Boston Red Sox and was the American League Batting Champion. For 11 years he was the 3<sup>rd</sup> baseman for the Oakland A's, retiring in 1992 –
