2020 Outstanding Female Scholar Athlete Award Winner - Morgane Gaucher



This year's award winner is described by her coach as one of the best team captains in his 35 years of coaching. He believes she excelled at taking responsibility and helping to support the coaching staff by embracing the leadership role and helping to give the team a sense of unity. Morgane Gaucher has been a part of the Wilcox Varsity Wrestling Program for all four years and is proud that she was a member of the first official "Girls" wrestling team this year. In her four years on the mat, she received a Most Improved Wrestler team honor, a Leadership Award team honor as well as the honor her senior year of being Most Valuable Wrestler. She was first team all-league for two years, placed 4th in CCS her junior year, and 3rd in CCS her senior year which led to her becoming a state qualifier both years. Morgane also spent a year on our swim team and three years as a diver. Morgane did all of this while maintaining a GPA of over 4.5 and is among one of Wilcox's highest GPA's of this graduating class. One of Morgane's teachers noted, "she puts forth her best effort into every assignment. Big and small. She's confident and courageous. Leads class discussions. Volunteers to read. Allows me to share her writing with the class. She's on time and is genuine, kind and wicked smart." Next year Morgane will be attending UC Davis to major in Mechanical Engineering.
