TOWN OF ELLINGTON NOTICE OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING – MAY 11, 2023 NOTICE OF REFERENDUM – MAY 23, 2023

A special Town Meeting of the electors and citizens qualified to vote in Town Meetings of the Town of Ellington, Connecticut, will be held in the Auditorium at Ellington High School, 37 Maple Street, Ellington, Connecticut, on Thursday, May 11, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. for the following purposes:

1. To consider and discuss, but not vote on, the recommendation of the Board of Selectmen and the Board of Finance, to amend the resolution approved by voters on March 1, 2022 increasing the appropriation and borrowing authorization by an additional \$12,960,000 (thereby increasing the appropriation and borrowing authorization approved by voters on March 1, 2022 to an aggregate \$74,600,000) for costs related to various renovations, improvements, and additions to Windermere Elementary School consisting of the demolition of a portion of the existing structure, anticipated to include a portion of the north classroom wing and the entire south classroom wing, construction of a new addition, renovations to a portion of the existing structure, anticipated to include the center classroom wing, a portion of the north classroom wing and existing assembly spaces, full roof replacement to the remaining portion of the structure, and various site improvements, anticipated to include lighting and parking lot improvements, and related work.

2. Pursuant to Sections 7-7 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Revision of 1958, as amended, and Sections 703 and 706 of the Town Charter, to adjourn said town meeting at its conclusion and to submit the resolution to be presented under item 1 of this Notice to referendum vote, which vote shall be held on Tuesday, May 23, 2023 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., in the manner provided by the Town Charter and said General Statutes. Electors and persons qualified to vote in town meetings who are not electors will vote at the Ellington Senior Center, 40 Maple Street in Ellington, Connecticut.

The aforesaid resolution will be submitted to the voters under the following heading:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF ELLINGTON APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL \$12,960,000 (INCREASING THE APPROPRIATION AND BORROWING AUTHORIZATION TO AN AGGREGATE \$74,600,000) FOR COSTS RELATED TO RENOVATIONS, IMPROVEMENTS, AND ADDITIONS TO WINDERMERE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND NOTES TO FINANCE THE PORTION OF THE PROJECT COST NOT PAID FROM GRANTS?”

Voters approving the resolution will vote "Yes" and those opposing said resolution will vote "No." Absentee ballots will be available from the Town Clerk's office. Absentee ballots will be counted centrally at the Ellington Senior Center, 40 Maple Street in Ellington.
