## **WEAPONS POLICY**

Students are forbidden to possess, handle, transmit or use any instrument in the school, on school grounds, at any school-sponsored activity or event, or any activity or event that bears a reasonable relationship to school, which is considered a weapon and/or incendiary or explosive device. A weapon includes, but is not limited to

(1) A firearm, meaning any gun, rifle, shotgun, weapon as defined by Section 921 of Title 18 of the United States Code, firearm as defined in Section 1.1 of the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act, or firearm as defined in Section 24-1 of the Criminal Code of 1961.

(2) A knife, brass knuckles or other knuckle weapon regardless of its composition, a billy club, or any other object if used or attempted to be used to cause bodily harm, including “look alikes” of any firearm as defined above.

Students will be in violation of this rule if they have these weapons or devices in their car parked on campus.

The Chicago Police Department will be notified immediately of any firearm incidents on school grounds. If a student is in possession of a firearm, her parents/guardian will also be notified immediately by school administration. Students who violate this policy will be subject to immediate suspension. Pending investigation by the Principal, proceedings for dismissal from Resurrection College Prep may begin immediately. This expulsion requirement may be modified by the Principal on a case by case basis.

All matters involving firearms shall be reported to the Illinois State Police through the School Incident Reporting System (SIRS) in IWAS.
