Student Grades: Skyward Access

Use parent portal to:

- Check grades - Click on S1 & S2
- Teacher Names
- Verify attendance, etc.
- Log-In Information to be given at registration

- Parents can request access of each teacher. Best practice is to review with student once a week.

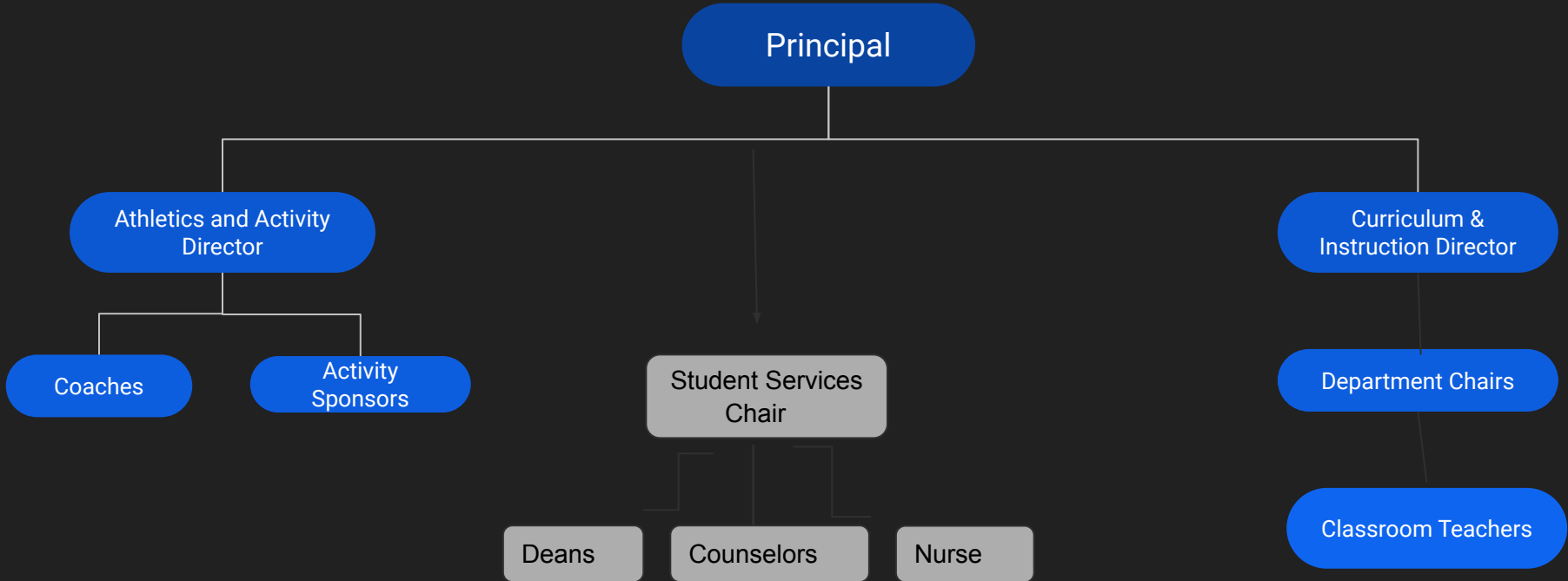
