To schedule any consultations, or to access other SFAP services, call 800-236-3231 and mention you are a family in the School District of South Milwaukee.

A parent or legally responsible adult must call to schedule services through the SFAP. More information is available in this **brochure**.

Issues that the SFAP may be able to help with include, but are not limited to:

- Anxiety and depression
- Academic pressure issues
- Marital/relationship issues
- Stress management
- Child/family issues
- Alcohol/drug issues
- Divorce/blended families
- Parenting concerns and questions

In addition to the SFAP services mentioned above, the SFAP also includes free:

- Legal consultation and mediation services
- Child care and elder care consultation, information, and referral
- Financial consultation
- School and college planning
- Adoption information
- Unlimited access to website search forms, self-assessment tools, and wellness materials

All SFAP services are completely free and confidential and all families with students in the School District of South Milwaukee are eligible to use the SFAP. Parents or guardians must call to initiate services.

Simply call 800-236-3231 Monday through Friday between 8:00am to 5:00pm and tell the SFAP staff that your child attends the School District of South Milwaukee and what services are of interest to you.
