

REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT ELECTIONEERING POLICY

The enforcement of the electioneering policy shall be the responsibility of the District Clerk, the Superintendent or his or her designee.

Upon notice of a violation with the electioneering policy, the District Clerk, the Superintendent or his or her designee shall verbally request the offending electioneering cease.

If upon verbal request the offending individual does not immediately cease electioneering the individual shall be warned that he or she is trespassing. If the individual disregards the direction to cease the electioneering the District Clerk shall advise the offending individual that law enforcement may be called. The District Clerk shall confer with the Superintendent or his or her designee to determine whether law enforcement shall be called.

The Superintendent shall decide whether to call law enforcement to come to the school who shall escort the offensive individual from the premises.

Under no circumstances may a school district employee engage in any physical contact with the offending individuals in the furtherance of this regulation.
