Please remember to keep a spare outfit in your child's backpack to be used in the event of an accident, spill, or mess here at school. This should include pants, a shirt, underwear and socks. If the student has spare clothes, the nurse will be able to assist them in cleaning up and get them back to class quickly.

Please fill out the front AND the back of the pink emergency card that was sent home with your child in their back to school blue communication folder ASAP. This information is necessary for the nurse to care for your child at school and to dismiss them quickly if they are ill or injured during the school day.



# Important Notes for Drop Off 2022-2023 School Year

<u>Please read the full document for Drop Off and Pick</u> <u>Up Procedures for the 2022-2023 School Year.</u>



There are two lanes for school traffic.

- The right lane (marked with blue arrows) is for drop off. EVERY parent wishing to drop students off must wait their turn in the drop off lane.
- The left lane (marked with a red arrow) is for traffic continuing past the drop off lane. Cars in this lane should NO LONGER attempt to drive past the line of cars, then cut back into the drop off lane. This is dangerous driving behavior that puts students, drivers



and staff at risk for an accident.

#### ◆ DRIVERS:

- Please pull up as far as possible (to the orange cone).
- Do not block crosswalks while car is stopped.
- Do not leave car unattended in drop off lane.
- Remain in your car during rolling drop-off.
- If you wish to exit your vehicle to accompany students to the door, please pull into the parking lot and park in a marked space.
- Do not drop students off in the parking lot.

#### **STUDENTS:**

- Exit cars on the right side, directly onto the sidewalk.
- Be ready to hop out as soon as the car is stopped.
- If your child is hesitant or not ready to get right out, please pull into the parking lot and park in a marked space. You can take as much time as you need there.
- If you wish to watch your children walk all the way in the door, please pull into the parking lot and park in a marked space. This will prevent anyone from blocking traffic in the drop off lane.


Please remember and understand that EVERY person waiting in the drop-off line feels their time is valuable.

#### What is a Gently Used book or DVD?

Think of it this way, would you buy a book if it's got a torn edge? Or a DVD that's missing its case? If you aren't sure if you should donate your items, check our guidelines below!

#### **Donating Guidelines:**

#### Books:

- (unless classics), and in a condition, you would consider buying for yourself or your family
- Categories for donation include fiction, nonfiction, hardcover, and paperback books for adults, children, and young adults
- We cannot accept textbooks, encyclopedias, dictionaries, medically related books, workbooks, or instruction manuals
- Please do not donate books with mold or mildew, or anything with torn covers or broken spines

#### CDs, Games, DVDs & BluRays:

- All books must be clean, relatively current DVDs, Games & Blu-Rays must be clean, functional, and in a condition, you would consider buying for yourself or your family
  - We do not accept CDs, video tape movies (VHS), anything with mold or mildew, or anything with a shattered case



Please bring donations packed in reasonably sized boxes or strong bags. Donations will be accepted during the week of August 23th-26th during open library hours.

Items that do not meet the above criteria cannot be accepted.
