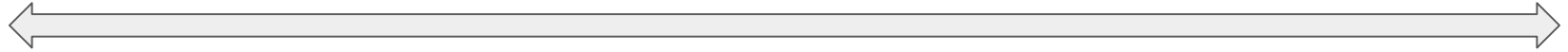


# Keio Academy of New York Covid-19 Alert Levels (Effective October 15, 2021)

1. Covid-19 positivity rate on-campus
2. Covid-19 positivity rate in Westchester County
3. Health Center isolation capacity

# 4 | Red Alert- Highest Risk

## WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- Significant increase in COVID-19 on campus with concern for reaching health center capacity to care for students  
**and/or...**
- Significant rate of infection in Westchester County (7 day average positivity rate greater than 10.0%) causing increased risk to the KANY community and concern for adequate supply of health center personnel, testing, and personal protective equipment

# 4 | Red Alert- Highest Risk

## PRECAUTIONS

### Health Protocol

- Maintain NY State Department of Health guidelines

### Face Masks

- Worn in all buildings, exceptions for student rooms, bathrooms, showerrooms.
- When outside: Worn when in groups of 2 or more

### House Life

- Students cohorted by House, no inter house visitation
- No room visitation
- North & South Rotundas are closed
- House Lounges are closed

### Academics

- All classes are virtual, in students' rooms

### Events & Meetings

- All events and meetings are virtual, in students' rooms

### House Sports & Athletics

- No athletic practices or games/competitions (including House Sports)

### Other Programs

- All programs are virtual, in students' rooms

### Meals

- All meals served in the boarding houses

## VISITATION: INBOUND

- Not permitted on-campus

# 3 | Orange Alert - Moderate Risk

## WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- COVID-19 has been diagnosed on campus

**and/or...**

- Incidence of COVID-19 is rising in Westchester County and indicators show risk of infection is increasing (7 day average positivity rate between 6.0% and 9.9%)

# 3 | Orange Alert- Moderate Risk

## PRECAUTIONS

### Health Protocol

- Maintain NY State Department of Health guidelines

### Face Masks

- Worn in all buildings, exceptions for student rooms, bathrooms, showerrooms, and when eating/drinking\*, or singing/playing a wind instrument in music/other classes/lessons.  
\*When finished eating/drinking, promptly put the mask back on
- When Outside: Worn when in groups of 2 or more

### House Life

- Students cohorted by House, no inter house visitation
- No room visitation
- North & South Rotundas are closed
- House Lounge capacity limits enforced

### Academics

- All classes are in-person, unless otherwise noted

### Events & Meetings

- In-person events and meetings need approval

### House Sports

- In-person as scheduled, unless otherwise noted

### Other Programs

- In-person as scheduled, unless otherwise noted

# 2 | Yellow Alert - Low Risk

## WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- There are no cases on campus

and...

- Prevalence of infection in Westchester County remains low but with the potential for increased transmission (7 day average positivity rate between 1.0% and 5.9%)

# 2 | Yellow Alert - Low Risk

## PRECAUTIONS

### Health Protocol

- Maintain NY State Department of Health guidelines

### Face Masks

- Worn in all buildings, exceptions for student rooms, bathrooms, shower rooms, when eating/drinking\*, or singing/playing a wind instrument in music/other classes/lessons.  
\*When finished eating/drinking, promptly put the mask back on
- When Outside: Worn when in groups of 2 or more. Exceptions for Athletic/House Sports

### House Life

- Interhouse visitation permitted\*
- Room Visitation: Maximum of 4 people in a room at any one time\*
- North & South Rotundas are available\*
- House Lounge capacity limits enforced\*  
\*with face mask on & maintain 3ft social distancing

# 1 | Blue Alert - Lowest Risk

## WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- There are no cases on campus
- Cases are rare and transmission is controlled throughout Westchester County (7 day average positivity rate below 1.0%)
- A vaccine or adequate treatment for COVID-19 is available

### Face Masks
