3 | Red Alert- High Risk

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- Significant increase in COVID-19 cases on campus with concern for reaching Health Center capacity to care for students
and/or...
- NY State's mandatory order of remote (online) classes

PRECAUTIONS

Health Protocol

- Maintain NY State Department of Health guidelines

Face Masks

- Worn on campus, except for student rooms, bathrooms, and shower rooms.

House Life

- Students cohorted by House, no inter-House visitation
- No room visitations
- North & South Rotundas are closed
- House Lounges are closed

Academics

- All classes are virtual, in students' rooms

Events & Meetings

- All events and meetings are virtual, in students' rooms

House Sports & Athletics

- No athletic practices or games/competitions (including House Sports)

Other Programs

- All programs are virtual, in students' rooms

Meals

- All meals served in the boarding houses

VISITATION: INBOUND

Commuter Students

- Not permitted on-campus

Deliveries

- No Food Deliveries

Visitors

- No visitors

Faculty & Staff

- Essential services, resident faculty, essential daytime faculty and staff are permitted

VISITATION: OUTBOUND

Travel

- No Day or Overnight trips
- Travel will be permitted for emergencies or other approved cases

2 | Yellow Alert - Medium Risk

- COVID-19 has been diagnosed on campus

and/or...

- Rate of infection of COVID-19 is in high or medium level in Westchester County according to **COVID Act Now** parameters and indicators show risk of infection is increasing or stays high.

Face Masks

- Indoors: Worn in all buildings, exceptions for student rooms, bathrooms, and shower rooms.
- Outdoors: Optional

- Interhouse visitation permitted
- Room visitation permitted
- North & South Rotundas are available
- House Lounges are available

Academics

- All classes are in-person

Events & Meetings

- Held In-person

House Sports & Athletics

- In-person as scheduled

- In-person as scheduled
