## STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES AND REQUIREMENTS 1 2 **Authority** 3 Alexandria City Public Schools shall comply with the Code of Virginia requirements in matters 4 5 relating to health, physical examinations, and inoculations. Interpretation of such regulations shall be sought from the Alexandria City Department of Health. The School Board may employ 6 7 doctors, school nurses, licensed practical nurses, physical therapists, occupational therapists and 8 speech therapists who meet such standards as may be determined by the Board of Education. 9 10 **Contagious Disease** ACPS will follow school exclusion guidelines as written by the American Academy of Pediatrics 11 and the Virginia Department of Health for contagious disease. 12 13 **Treatment of Medical Emergencies** 14 15 No treatment of injuries, except first aid, will be given in the schools.
