Parents will learn how vaping nicotine and other substances can affect the brain and body.

In 2022, about 1 in 10 or more than 2.5 million U.S. middle and high school students used e-cigarettes

The most commonly used devices are disposables (55.3%), followed by prefilled/refillable pods or cartridges (25.2%).

Most Youth who begin vaping nicotine move on to vaping THC and marijuana - sometimes unknowingly. Nicotine is a precursor to marijuana abuse in adolescents.
