



REQUEST FOR PARKING PERMIT FOR THE 2023-24 SCHOOL YEAR

Permits will be issued in the following order: Special needs consideration, seniors, juniors, sophomores.

*****NOTE: Only apply if you have a valid driver's license (you may not be under suspension, license revoked, or have only a temporary permit, etc.)**

You must purchase a parking permit and complete a registration each year. You will be issued a new permit sticker each school year.

In applying for a parking permit, students and parents/guardians understand and agree to the following:

1. Permits are issued to students who must drive every day. If several students carpool and rotate driving responsibilities, one space can be assigned to the pool and a permit issued to each car involved. **If you intend to carpool, please apply together and turn in your forms stapled together.**
2. Parking fee for 2023-2024: **\$100.00** for all student parking. **The parking fee is due when your form is turned in. Parking will be offered at a pro-rated fee of \$60 if purchased any time after the beginning of the second semester.**
3. Parking stickers **must be affixed** to the passenger side of the front window. Failure to comply may result in the loss of parking privileges.
4. Every car parked in the school lots during the day must be registered with the school. The parking coordinator (Susan Rohlfs) must be notified by 7:40 a.m. and given the reason if a non-registered car is in the lot.
5. **Parking is not permitted in Guardian Angels or Mount Washington Presbyterian Church lots. The Mount Washington Presbyterian lot is not to be used as an entrance to or exit from McNicholas parking lot.**
6. Students applying for a permit agree to abide by the following school regulations:
 - No speeding or reckless driving when entering or exiting parking lots (i.e. squealing tires, riding on car hood, riding in back of pickup truck, etc.)
 - No loitering in parking lot or sitting in parked cars
 - No smoking in parking lot or parked cars
 - No parking in areas designated as NO PARKING, BUSES ONLY, FACULTY PARKING, HANDICAPPED, VISITOR, or other striped off areas at any time
 - No driving on or through grassy areas or behind the school from lower lot to upper lot.
 - **No parking in the faculty lot at any time** (Students are not to park in the faculty lot before school for practice or move their cars into the faculty lot after dismissal.)

Violation of these regulations may result in one or more of the following: detentions, Saturday work detail, suspension, or loss of parking privileges.

Your application will not be processed if any information is missing/incomplete (i.e. signature, license number)
