What is this? A space in the free store where students can get free toiletries items (travel sized soap, toothpaste, mouthwash), and feminine hygiene products.

Why is This Important? Feminine hygiene products and other toiletries products are expensive and not everyone can afford this on top of everything else. We decided to place these products on the shelves so that students who need them have access to them regardless of their financial situation. There's an emphasis on the variety of the products so people have access to what they're comfortable using (sustainable sewn products, tampons, cups, etc...)
