New Spot on Campus: The Cultural Center!

This year Kirby opened a brand new space on our campus, The Cultural Center. Located on our 3rd floor along our Roof Deck, the mission of the Cultural Center is to create a space for students and teachers to bring aspects of culture that are important in their own lives, to the entire school community. Through Yakira Landaverry's (Science Teacher) original vision, Fatima Zavala Ruiz (School Counselor), Louis Infante (Science Teacher) and Ricardo Cruz-Anzaldo (Music Teacher) working alongside Ayesha Sumbal (Assistant Head of School for DEI & Student Life) have brought this space to life.



The Cultural Center has hosted celebrations to honor the Jewish holidays, Día de los Muertos, and Lunar New Year. They have hosted Open Mic afternoons, as well as a guest lecture from a UCSC professor who gave a talk on the cultural and historical context behind our fall musical, *Fiddler on the Roof.* In addition, for Black History month the center hosted a week-long film festival showcasing the works of black filmmakers. They have also made a safe space to discuss current events as they come up.

The space was also the place to be on campus to catch the World Cup during lunch. There is always a teacher present to chat with students in the Cultural Center, which features fuzzy rainbow bean bag chairs, teas from around the world, and various artifacts that signify various cultural holidays. The Cultural Center has become an integral part of our school, and we are looking forward to seeing the ways that it will continue to help our community celebrate all the cultures that are represented at Kirby.


