

## Assembly Bill 1806 Verification

The below-named student is experiencing homelessness and may be eligible for the provisions of Assembly Bill (AB) 1806 (2014), as the student has changed schools after completing two years of high school. In order to comply with state law, please complete the following information within thirty (30) days of enrolling student.

**AB 1806** exempts homeless youth who transfer after completing their second year of high school from local graduation requirements if they would not be able to reasonably complete them at the time of transfer. Local graduation requirements include any requirements related to credits.

I understand that agreeing to graduate according to the guidelines of **Assembly Bill 1806 may affect my eligibility to gain admission to a post-secondary educational institute or some branches of the military and release the school district from any liability that may result.** Assembly Bill 1806 allows eligible homeless youth the right to remain in school for a 5th year to complete local graduation requirements. In addition, I understand that the district is not liable if the student, parent or guardian provides false or misleading information. In compliance with AB1806 and EC 51225.1 (i) the district shall not revoke the exemption.
