<u>Future Angus Stockmen Scholarship</u>--\$1000 HS Seniors or college undergraduate pursuing a degree in an agriculture field of study. Applicant or applicant's parents must have transferred or have been transferred a registration paper in the last 36 months; applicant or applicant

RISE Financial Progress Scholarship Program-five scholarships of \$5,000 each for college students who complete 10 online financial courses and discuss how it will help them achieve their financial goals. Applicants must be undergraduate students (or planning to be in the upcoming semester) with a minimum grade point average of 2.0. Only first 1000 applications accepted. Deadline—May 1<sup>st</sup>

<u>Associated General Contractors Academic Scholarships</u>—over \$30,000 awarded to students enrolling in a construction-related, post-secondary technical college or university. Deadline—May 1<sup>st</sup>

<u>South Dakota Cattlewomen's Scholarship</u>—Graduating HS Seniors and undergraduate students. Deadline—May 10<sup>th</sup>.
