It's Pirate Football Tailgating Season!



PHS is once again offering tailgate spaces for purchases for the home football games. To purchase one season-long tailgate space is \$200 for 5 people or \$400 for 10 people. This cost allows you to tailgate in the designated area to the west of the stadium for all of Piper's home football games. This price also includes admission to the game for all of the people in your group.

Tailgating is limited to the tailgate lot only. The lot will open after 5:00 p.m. on game days and close promptly after the game. Parking is limited to the designated tailgating space. Any other guests arriving separately will need to park in the high school or middle school parking lots.

Location: The tailgate will occur in the flat grassy area to the west of the stadium. The tailgate area is circled on the map.

Directions: Turn onto N 110th St. from Hutton Rd. Travel past the baseball stadium and football stadium. Turn into the grass lot. Check-in with the table at the front of the lot and park in the spot directed by staff.
