### Summer School

#### Traditional Summer School

(Classes 2016, 2017 and 2018)

Traditional Summer School is designed for the student who benefits from face-to-face interaction with the instructor and a shared learning environment with peers. Intervention specialists are available in the classroom for students needing additional help with content. Classes satisfy NCAA requirements and are factored into the high school GPA.

Semester I: June 29, 2015 – July 17, 2015

Semester II: July 20, 2015 – August 6, 2015

#### Class of 2015 Senior Cohort Credit Recovery

(Current students in grade 12)

Senior Credit Recovery is reserved for the Class of 2015 students needing to meet graduation requirements by August 2015.

#### Credit Recovery Summer School

(Classes 2016 and 2017)

Dates: June 29, 2015 – August 6, 2015

Credit Recovery Summer School is designed for the student who has previously taken a course but still needs to master some content standards. Course is graded on a pass/fail basis and does not satisfy NCAA core requirements or factor into the high school GPA.

#### Digital Learning Summer School

Digital Learning Summer School is designed for the independent learner with strong computer skills and a high reading ability. Computers will be available onsite or the student may work from another location. Students will complete majority of curriculum at their own pace but must report to summer school site for testing.

## Tuition

The tuition for Akron Public Schools students is \$125 for each semester / \$250 for both semesters.

Non-Akron Public Schools students are defined as students not enrolled in Akron Public Schools for the 2014-15 school year. The tuition for non-Akron Public Schools students is \$140 for each semester / \$280 for both semesters.

All courses are 1/2 credit with the exception of Physical Education, which equals 1/4 credit.
