



DISTRICT INSTRUMENT USE

Information for parents/guardians

The Shoreline School District Instrument Loan program is designed to support access for all students to participate in our Band and Orchestra programs. Because of limited resources, our loan instruments are made available on a first come, first served basis. As we can only offer what we have, students using a school instrument have reduced choice in an instrument.

We ask that your request for a district loan instrument be based on a consideration of need, not convenience. Funds collected for the use of District instruments are used for the repair and upkeep of the instruments.

A non-refundable fee of \$50 per school year is required for each student playing a district owned instrument. If full payment cannot be made in a single payment, monthly payments are an option. Shoreline School District is committed to providing a learning community, which engages all students regardless of financial barriers. If you need financial assistance to access any district programs, please contact your school's family advocate (elementary) or your student's counselor (secondary). After turning in the form below, your school instrumental teacher will connect with your student and give them an Instrument Use Agreement. This agreement will need to be signed before the instrument can be delivered. The condition of the instrument will be inspected by the music teacher prior to checkout and again after its return. Any student using a District owned instrument is fully responsible for the care of that instrument.
