**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-11**

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
WITH THE ORGANIZATION FOR EDUCATION TECHNOLOGY AND  
CURRICULUM**

WHEREAS, after a competitive bidding and selection process by The Organization for Education Technology and Curriculum ("OETC"), a number of Vendors have or will enter into Master Agreements to provide a variety of goods, products and services (herein "Products") based on national volumes; and

WHEREAS, Master Agreements are made available by OETC and provide that Participating Public Agencies may purchase Products on the same terms, conditions and pricing as the Lead Public Agency, subject to any applicable local purchasing ordinances and the laws of the state of purchase; and

WHEREAS, school districts in the State of Washington are authorized by RCW 28A.320 and RCW 39.34 to enter into cooperative agreements for the purchase of various Products; and

WHEREAS, Shoreline School District desires to reduce costs in purchasing various Products for use in the school district; and

WHEREAS, the Parties recognize and find that this Agreement will permit the Parties to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with each other on a basis of mutual advantage and that it is in each of their best interests to cooperate and join in certain purchasing activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Shoreline School District No. 412, King County, Washington agrees as follows:

1. That a joint purchasing agency by and between Shoreline School District No. 412 and OETC be formed as an interlocal cooperative for the purpose of procuring various equipment, supplies and services.
2. This Agreement shall allow the purchase or acquisition of goods and services by Shoreline School District directly from a third party vendor if a provision has been made in the lead agency's contract with that third party vendor that permits other agencies to avail themselves of the goods and services offered under the contract.
3. This Agreement shall remain in force until terminated by either Party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other Party.
4. The Superintendent or designee of Shoreline School District No. 412 is hereby designated as a representative to the joint purchasing agency and the Superintendent or designee is further authorized to execute and implement the requisite agreement or agreements to accomplish this purpose.

5. Shoreline School District reserves the right to contract purchases independently, with or without notice to the other Party. This Agreement does not obligate either party to acquire goods or services through the contractual agreements of the other Party.






