INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR TITLE I PRIVATE SCHOOL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the <u>Shoreline School District</u> (participating district) has within its boundaries resident students who qualify for Title I services and attend a <u>Seattle School District</u> non-public school as defined by OSPI participation requirements.

WHEREAS, the <u>Seattle School District</u> (serving District) provides Title I, Part A services which appropriately meet the educational needs of qualifying non-public school as defined by OSPI participation requirements.

THEREFORE, the <u>Seattle School District</u> and the <u>Shoreline School District</u> enter into this agreement for the purpose of establishing an interdistrict cooperative program for Title I, Part A students.

The <u>Seattle School District</u> and the <u>Shoreline School District</u> agree as follows:

- I. This agreement shall be for the 2021-2022 school year, with educational services intended to commence on or before October 31, 2021 and to terminate July 30, 2022. Final invoices to be submitted to the serving school district by August 31, 2022.
- II. Shoreline School District agrees to release Title I, Part A equitable share funds to Seattle School District for tutoring services for Title I, Part A qualified student addresses associated Title I, Part A school area.

Equitable Share school amounts for student services were generated by Title I, Part A financial need Title I, Part A school area as follows

<u>\$774</u> is generated by 1 qualifying student address enrolled at <u>Holy Rosary School</u> <u>\$774</u> is generated by 1 qualifying student address enrolled at <u>Christ the King School</u>

- III. The serving district will be the fiscal agent providing Title I, Part A services and employees to provide services to eligible students attending above named non-public schools. Services records are housed and maintained at the serving district and available to the participating district should they become necessary in an audit.
- IV. Title I services will provide education assistance and support to supplement the educational needs of struggling students in the areas of English Language Arts or Mathematics or any other allowable supplemental services as named in the school Title IA record of agreed upon services.
- V. The joint financing arrangements are to be conducted in accordance with regulations of the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction. Final settlement will be determined upon the close of all accounts for the 2021-2022 school year.
- VI. When this interdistrict cooperation agreement is terminated any unfunded liabilities shall be shared by the serving and participating districts on a pro-rata basis as to full time equivalent pupils served in the program.
- VII. This agreement terminates August 31, 2022, unless it is extended for a one-year period by mutual written agreement of the parties prior to August 31, 2022.
