This emailed letter is an update to the letter you received via mail last week.

Parking

Limited premium parking passes are available NOW for pre-purchase for \$20.00 each at the VHHS Student Store for on-campus parking on the lower courts accessible off Irma Street. Guests may also choose to park for free on the street following posted signs. Guest requiring ADA access must be dropped off at the football gate located on Hillrose Ave. ADA access is not available through parking on the premium parking lower courts.

Graduation Ceremony Guests

- Each graduating senior will receive **5** graduation tickets following the MANDATORY Graduation Rehearsal on June 7, 2023.
- Extra Tickets with premium track seating are available NOW for purchase for \$20.00 each at the VHHS Student Store.

Graduation Cap and Gowns

- Graduation cap and gown are NOW available for purchase for \$ 17.20 at the VHHS Student Store to keep as a graduation memento.
- **Students who do NOT pre-purchase their cap and gown must return the gown in good condition when they come to collect their diploma (also bring ID) starting Tuesday June 13th at 9:00am.**

The graduation ceremony is **Wednesday, June 7, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.** at Verdugo Hills High School's Turner Field. To qualify, students must meet all graduation requirements. If you are unsure of your child's eligibility, contact your child's counselor.

Students eligible to receive their High School Diploma and participate in the Graduation Ceremony will receive an official confirmation letter and clearance form the week of June 1, 2023.

Mandatory Rehearsals

- **Students must attend BOTH Mandatory Graduation Rehearsals**
 - Tuesday June 6, 2023 Graduation Rehearsal 8:30 am (report to Auditorium) followed by Senior Breakfast and Cap and Gown Distribution.

- Wednesday June 7, 2023 Graduation Rehearsal 8:30 am (report to Auditorium). 5 guest tickets will be distributed.

Ceremony Arrival

5:00 pm- GRADUATES report to Auditorium. Gates will open for guests and seating will be available starting at 5:00 p.m.

Appropriate Attire/Dress Code

Graduates must wear their school issued graduation regalia (cap and gown, Class of 2023 Sash, additional **school-issued** cords and sashes). Cap and gowns may not be altered.

*Students may not bring bags, purses, or cells phones with them to the Graduation Ceremony.

Gifts, Flowers, Balloons, Photos, etc.

Please hold any gifts or flowers until after the ceremony, as students will not be allowed to carry them during the ceremony. **Balloons, noise makers, and horns will not be allowed.** Please do not bring umbrellas or any item that may obstruct the view of others.
