| 2301 | Australia: Exploring Extraordinary Countries! | This week we will explore Australia. Focusing on the countries culture, traditions, way of life, similarities & differences from other countries through books/videos, crafts, discussions etc. | K-3 |
| 2302 | It's Not Magic... It's Science-Original | Have you ever wondered how things in the natural world happen? Participants will investigate a natural phenomenon daily by performing science experiments, gathering evidence, and making a claim to explain why. Daily science labs will involve hands-on learning that excite and engage. Remember, it's not magic...it's science! | 4-5 |
| 2303 | "It's Not Magic.... It's Science-Enhanced" | We had so much fun last summer with the Original session, we decided to make another version with more science activities! Participants will investigate through hands- on experiments across a variety of science disciplines. | 4-5 |

Students in grades 2-5 will get the opportunity to learn, grow, play, and explore by tapping into their creative side. We will also be creating sock puppets and learning how to bring them to life. A portion of the tuition will go to the Robotics Team costs for 2023-24. | 4-8 |
| 2310 | What is Envirothon? | Students will learn the concepts and skills required to compete in the 2024 Kentucky Envirothon Competition which is an environmental and natural resource conservation problem-solving, teambuilding experience for high school students (grades 9-12). Incorporating STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) principles, experiential learning and hands-on outdoor field experiences, the Envirothon fosters student learning in the areas of AQUATIC ECOLOGY, FORESTRY, SOILS and LAND USE, WILDLIFE, and CURRENT ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES. There are 5 students per team, students can form their own teams. This course will focus on tree ID and measurements, compass and pacing skills, collecting and identifying bugs in a stream, and basic soil classification skills.
