## **Engineering Principles of Precision Machining, Precision Machining, and CNC**

Machinist Ready Reference (\$40), 3-Ring Loose Leaf Notebook, Calculator with Trig Functions, Safety Glasses, Work Clothes, steel toe shoes or boots, cut proof gloves, USB drive. Students should plan on spending between \$150-200 minimum for required personal protective equipment.

## Welding Technology

Welding students will be given a complete list of required equipment at the beginning of school. Equipment needed is also available on the USD 373 website or contact the weld instructor for a list. Students should plan on spending between \$200-300 minimum for required personal protective equipment. The program also requires a \$200 material fee per year.

Note: Welding students who wear prescription eye glasses must purchase prescription safety glasses with side shields or a pair of safety glasses that can be worn over eyeglasses. Standard Z87.1 safety glasses will not fit over prescription glasses.

## **Geometry in Construction**
