



- 5. Identify and define earthworms
- 6. Identify where earthworms live, look like, eat, are eaten by, and how they help the environment
- 7. Identify earthworm life cycle
- 8. Identify and define weaving
- 9. Identify and define warp and weft
- 10. Overview project
- 11. Students follow steps to create project
- 12. Reflect on artwork using Student Reflection Sheet
- 13. Student's self assess using the Rubric
