LaGrange, GA., May 2, 2023 – A Troup County School System bus monitor was arrested on May 2, 2023, after an incident was discovered after reviewing bus camera footage.

The incident involved the bus monitor making inappropriate physical contact with a student. There was no report of injury.

The district reported the allegation to law enforcement and The Department of Family and Children Services. TCSS is not at liberty to discuss the situation any further as it is a personnel matter and to protect the identity of the student involved.
