#### **Summer School 2023- Schedules and Fees**

The 2023 Summer School session will run Monday, June 12<sup>th</sup> through Friday, June 30th. Class times are 8:00 am-9:45 am and 10:05 am-11:50 am, with a few exceptions. Supervision is provided between classes for students in grades Pre-K through 8th. The district <u>does not</u> provide bus transportation before, after or between classes.

**Online course registration has closed.** Students' summer school class schedules are posted in the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. To view your student's schedule:

- After logging into the Portal, click on Schedule in the left column.
- If necessary, choose 22-23 Summer School from the Enrollment drop down menu.
- The "A" section is your child's 8am class. The "B" section is the 10:05am class. If your student is registered for a Speed and Strength training class, it will be listed below the B section.
- The Basketball, Football and Speed & Strength classes don't follow the "A" and "B" time schedules. Please check those class times in the Catalog.

If a course you already requested doesn't appear on your student's schedule:

1. The class is full and your student remains on a wait list. You will be notified if a seat opens due to a cancellation; **OR** 2. You requested a class that didn't match your student's <u>current</u> grade level, and the request was denied.

Here is a <u>list of courses</u> that still have openings. Course descriptions and more information can be found in the <u>Catalog</u>. To register a student for one of these courses, contact summer school secretary Kerry Guyette at <u>kguyette@depere.k12.wi.us</u>, or 983-9174, ext 4013, from 7:30am-12:30pm on school days. **New registrations will be accepted through May 19.** 

Mrs. Guyette also **must** be contacted in order to drop a class from your student's schedule.

Some courses have fees for supplies. Fees will be posted to your student's account in June, and can be paid in the Portal with a credit card. Payment also can be made in person with cash or check at the High School office. Room and teacher assignments will be communicated in June.

#### Youth Apprenticeship

De Pere High School offers Work-Based Experiential Learning Experiences like job-shadowing, internships, supervised paid employment, and apprenticeships. These opportunities allow students to earn valuable knowledge and skills outside of the high school classrooms while taking related coursework inside of the classrooms. Our youth apprenticeship program is conducted and managed in partnership with the CESA 7 and the Green Bay Chamber of Commerce. Students can earn school elective credits, along with certifications from the Department of Workforce Development. Mrs. Corey Wollin is the Youth Apprenticeship Coach serving DPHS.

#### **Hope Squad Parent Newsletter**

Hope Squad is a school-based peer support team, made up of students who are nominated by their peers, that partners with local mental health agencies. Research shows that children and young adults who are contemplating suicide are more likely to reach out to their peers than the adults in their lives. In this way, Hope Squad members are the "eyes and ears" of the school building – monitoring for warning signs of suicide



and helping to connect their peers with staff members who can offer the appropriate resources in times of need. The Unified School District of De Pere has Hope Squad teams at Foxview, DPMS, and DPHS. We will be sharing a monthly parent newsletter produced by Hope Squad with some practical parenting tips. We hope you find a helpful nugget of wisdom in these brief newsletters.

Teens can obtain a permit in WI at age 15.

- Teens will not be allowed to apply for their probationary license until they are at least 16 years old, hold their permit for at least 6 months ticket free, practice hours of at least 50 hours and 10 of those at night, and have completed all of driver education (classroom and BTW lessons).
- Another change is that the **permit will be good for 18 months** instead of 12 months. The DMV has *not* announced when they will sunset the parental road test waiver; however the waiver program is ending and all 16-17 year olds **will have to take the road test**.
- The new law changes the number of practice hours required during the permit phase, it changed from **30** hours to **50** hours. The DMV does not collect the practice driving record when teens go for their road test however they may ask to see it or the **Road Ready app** which also tracks practice time.
- Your teen should work toward at least 100 hours of practice with 30 of those at night based on national recommendations put forth by AAA Foundation research in order to give novice drivers more experience before licensing (shows it reduces crashes after licensing). Our common goal for everyone is to have fewer crashes, injuries, and fatalities involving teens and all other drivers. Use of the Road Ready app is a great tool for them to track their progress of practice hours.

Who is eligible to enroll? Any student who is 14 years/10 months to 18 years old. Sign up information is located on the De Pere High School webpage under the "Students" tab under the Driver's Education link. We also have paper forms that you can pick up in the high school office.


