On Wednesday, Year 2 went to Kew Gardens to become plant scientists. The boys had a great day exploring the different green houses and learning about the different plants that are grown in each. We had a fantastic outdoor learning session about the parts of a plant and seed dispersal through wind or animals. The boys became 'squirrels' hiding their 'acorns' to show how animals disperse seeds but sometimes forget their locations allowing for a new tree to grow. The boys then had a chance to do some observational drawing, looking at pollen through a microscope and discussing the importance of pollinators. We were very lucky to stay dry for most of the day-fantastic learning Year 2!
