 Subject: **Mandatory Summer Professional Learning-2023**

Based on the new contract, Charles County Public Schools (CCPS) may require up to two trainings for certificated staff based on school system needs. Required training courses attended on days that are not designated workdays for the employee will be compensated at their per diem rate. The required trainings may also be offered during a normal workday for no additional compensation or after a designated workday at the pre-established training stipend. Staff members may be excused prior to training with permission from the principal and Chief of Schools for unavoidable conflicts. Employees hired after the training dates and staff members who were excused will be provided with options to take the trainings at alternate times.

Teachers must attend the following professional learning opportunities on the days listed below or at another time when offered. All mandatory professional learning will be held on Thursday, Aug. 17, and Friday, Aug. 18. Specific locations will be sent out at a later date. Registration for the mandatory courses will open in [PowerSchool](#) on May 1.
