- Aurelia Payne, Program Director at the Harris County Public Health presented on LEAD poisoning
 prevention and stats. This is a grant program since 2017 that provides outreach and education
 in schools and communities. Harris County alone, has 646 children with dangerous lead levels in
 their blood. Most of these children are under 6 years of age, and live in urban, low income,
 Medicaid communities. Although, there is no cure for lead poisoning, washing hands, bottles,
 pacifiers, and nutritious eating, can help to prevent lead poisoning.
- Sgt. Novosad presented on Summer Safety. Water safety was discussed whether it be home/pool, or vacation. River, lake, or beach. Heat safety; hydrate often! Digital safety; accessing devices, monitoring your children, location devices. Know your child's friends! Gun safety; location, security, familiarity. Safes, locks.
- During Open Discussion: Billye Trader asked for SHAC meeting topics for the upcoming 2023/24 school year.
