Field Day is May 19th

We are excited to be able to host Field Day again here at Meridian and invite our parents to come out and watch. This year Field Day will be held on **Friday, May 19, 2023 from 8:30am-2:30pm (grades 3-5 8:30-11:00 / K-2 12:00-2:30)**. **Prior to attending events, parents must check in at the main office. This will allow you to get a visitor's badge and help us ensure the safety of all students.**

Your student will be rotating through 12 stations (12 minutes including travel time) run by students from Westlake's Honor Society. These stations consist of games that they have learned throughout physical education class this year. PTO has also paid for an inflatable obstacle course as one of the stations, which I know the kids will really enjoy. A huge thank you to our awesome PTO and to all the efforts that went into fundraising during the Mustang Mile so we could provide this! Please make sure you send your child with a large water bottle that will be traveling with them station to station. There will not be a refill station so please make sure you send one large enough to last the entire ½ day. It is a good idea to put their name on their bottle in case it gets left behind. Also, be sure they have sunscreen on before coming to school.

Please note, there will be **NO hot lunch served on Field Day**. Students may bring a sack lunch from home, or if you fill out the Google form, the cafeteria will provide them with a sack lunch in lieu of the regular cafeteria service. These forms needed to be submitted no later than May 4, 2023. **Kids that did not request a cold lunch from the cafeteria by May 4th using the google form sent by Mrs. Smith must bring their own sack lunch on Field Day.**

We invite you to come out and watch your student but do ask if you are bringing along other siblings that don't attend Meridian, that you make sure they are with you at all times. They should be cheering on and watching their siblings. Unfortunately, as much as I would like to say they can participate in the activities, it's not safe or feasible for them to do so. We would like to thank our PTO for supplying one Kona Ice for each Meridian Student during field day. However, **the Kona Ice truck will be only for Meridian students**. Others will **not** be able to make purchases that day.
