

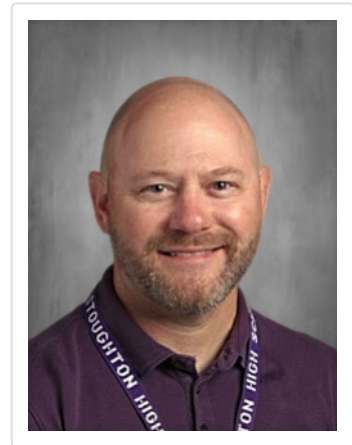

Please read carefully for your grade's procedures

End of Year Chromebook Instructions

SENIOR INSTRUCTIONS

Seniors will turn in their Chromebooks, charging cords, and cases in the Multipurpose Room on Tuesday, May 30, and Wednesday, May 31. Seniors who do not return these items will not be allowed to go on the Senior Trip.

There is a \$35 fee for a lost charging cord and a \$200 fee for a lost or damaged Chromebook.

GRADES 9 - 11 INSTRUCTIONS

Students who are currently in grades 9 - 11 will be allowed to keep their Chromebooks and cords over the summer, provided they will be returning to SASD for the 2023 - 2024 school year. Students who will be leaving the District must turn in all of their technology before leaving.

Any students who have lost their charging cords should see Ms. Gargano in the library for a replacement. There is a \$35 fee for a lost cord, which can be paid through Infinite Campus. If a student's Chromebook is not working properly, please see Ms. Gargano as soon as possible to get a working Chromebook for the summer.

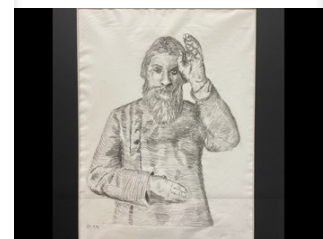
Congratulations, Top Scholars!

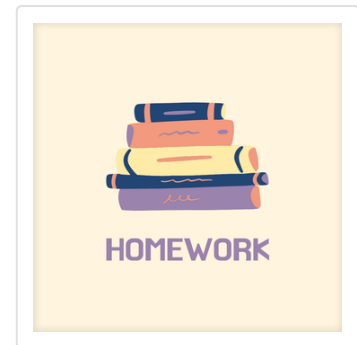
Important dates to mark on your calendar for the upcoming 2023-2024 school year:

Child Work Permits Moving to Online Only, In-Person Ends June 30

As you may have heard, the Department of Workforce Development's Equal Rights Division has developed a new online work permit application tool. The Division carefully considered the lessons of the past few years, when pandemic restrictions made it nearly impossible for some minors to obtain work permits and decided to pursue an online application that would be available to the parents of minors 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from any computer, tablet, smartphone, or similar device. The application improves accessibility for minors who live in rural or underserved areas and eliminates the difficult logistics involved in working parents having to take off work to make a trip to a work permit office.

The application is live now. A parent can access the site [using these instructions](#). Payment is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit or debit card or by ACH direct withdrawal. Once the permit application process is complete, the Department mails a paper copy of the permit directly to the employer.

The old system will continue to be operational until June 30, 2023, when it will be discontinued. The offices of schools in Stoughton will no longer be issuing work permits.

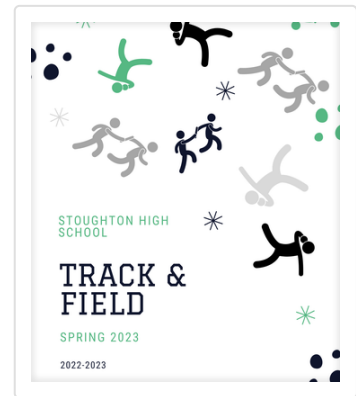
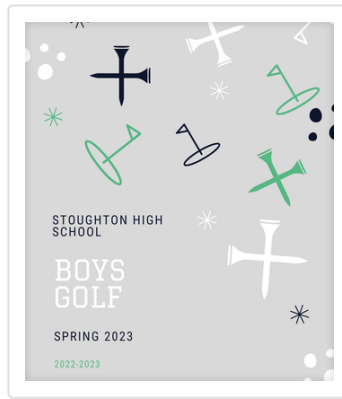
