Topics—

1— Bleachers at the ES and HS—Brent explained that removing the top row of each set would allow for more team side line space as per guidelines. He shared the quotes received. This will occur over the summer.

2—ES and HS gym floors—Brent reviewed the need to reseal both floors this summer. There is a company that will train our staff how to seal them. Brent had received quotes. He is contacting the companies again to request new quotes and inquire about labor costs. Next summer the ES gym floor will need a complete resurfacing.

3—Bathroom project—Bid reveal is scheduled for May 22, 2018 at 1:00 PM.

4—Drama shed purchase has been made and placement is confirmed. The permit application and check have been sent.

5—Tech sound/light board area in HS auditorium—discussed having the drafting class make a platform for the sound/light board. Jim is working on this. It could involve the removal of 6 seats. It will allow more movement around the back of the location. We are looking into a cover to protect the sound/light board. This board will be sent for cleaning this summer.

6—The digital sign will be installed prior to Carnival. The building will be pressure washed. Location of sign will be a number of feet below the lettering that is there currently.

7—There was discussion about cameras and access to them. Roger inquired about poles or boulders for open spaces. We are waiting on the Center for Safe Schools recommendations.

8—Brent priced out the cost of replacing non-safety windows in classroom doors. He will be researching the cost of new classroom doors.

9—ES and HS vestibules—Jim shared plans for the ES and 3 options for the HS. It was decided to have drawings for the ES vestibule completed and option 3 for the HS was selected (involves minor changes).

10—Steve shared about potential changes to Plan Con and the possibility of safety money from the PA budget.
