The Effingham County Board of Education met in special session for a budget hearing on June 22, 2022 at 6:00PM with the following members present: F. Lamar Allen, Vickie Decker, Lynn Anderson, Jan Landing and Ben Johnson.

Lynn Anderson, Vice Chair, opened the meeting with an invocation.

F. Lamar Allen, Board Chair, led meeting participants in the Pledge of Allegiance.

In a motion by Jan Landing and a second by Ben Johnson, Board members voted unanimously to adopt the meeting agenda with no additions or deletions.

Dr. Yancy Ford led the discussion regarding the FY23 budget. He shared his recommendation to approve the FY23 budget with a no-roll-back millage rate with the rate remaining at 15.810. He reviewed projected FY23 revenues and expenditures and outlined factors that have impacted the budget, including residential and industrial growth. Dr. Ford advised that the district must plan responsibly in order to allow for increased enrollment, additional positions, and increased fuel costs for school district vehicles. Dr. Ford gave Board members an opportunity to comment or ask questions. There were no questions or comments from Board members. F. Lamar Allen opened the floor to questions from those present at the meeting (ECSD employees only as no members of the general public were in attendance). There were no questions or comments.

With no further business, Board members voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at approximately 6:25pm in a motion by Vickie Decker and a second by Jan Landing.
