

Effingham 4-H Scholarship Portfolio & Application

4-H Leadership Scholarship (\$1000) and 4-H Educational Scholarship (\$500)

Requirements:

- Submit one portfolio, it will be considered for both scholarships. The portfolio must contain the following items:
 - A one-page cover letter. The cover letter is a tool of introduction. Any information about any time in your life that you feel is important should be in this letter. Also, address your future goals and plans.
 - Two pages of accomplishments. These two pages should be an outline of your 4-H career beginning with 5th grade to the current year. Also include activities that you have shown leadership and citizenship qualities in your church, school and community.
 - A completed scholarship certification page (attached).
 - Two letters of recommendations.

Eligibility Rules:

- Must be an active Effingham County 4-H member during the current year.
- The 4-H member must be enrolled as a high school senior to apply. Note: If there are no 4-H members meeting the scholarship requirements, the scholarship will not be awarded.
- All applications shall be given due consideration without regard to race, color, sex, national origin or handicap status.
- The scholarship winners will be announced at the Annual 4-H Awards Program as well as the Senior Class Night.
- To receive the scholarship, the 4-H member must complete one full semester as a full-time student and have a 3.0 grade point average. It is the responsibility of the 4-H member to bring their grades to the 4-H Office.
- Scholarship funds must be claimed within one calendar year of high school graduation.
