




Google Classroom For Parents





What is Google Classroom?


Google Classroom (GC) is your child's digital link to learning.

Educators use GC to share assignments, homework, newsletters, and other educational resources with students and parents.




You are now signed in to your Google for Education account!

Students can click on the Chrome App Launcher (waffle or rubik's cube) to access Google apps.




