SHIRTS AND TOPS



- ♦ TYPE: Collared Polo Style or SE t-shirt
- COLORS: Maroon, Black, White, or Gray
- FRIDAY SHIRTS: On Fridays, students may wear approved T-shirts representing SEHS clubs, activities, or athletics. These shirts may be worn on Fridays only, and they must represent activities related to South Effingham High School.
- UNDERSHIRT: Solid Black, White, Navy, or Gray
- NO Insignia larger than a credit card
- NO Pockets
- NO Button down, Oxford style
- ECCA students may wear ECCA approved shirts

Collared Polo Style or SE t-shirt Maroon, Black, White, or Gray:



BOTTOMS



- TYPE: Pants/Slacks, Capris, Shorts, Skirts, Skorts, or Jumpers
- COLORS: Solid Khaki, Navy, or Black
- FIT: No more than 5" above the bend on the back of the knee and worn at the waist

- NO Insignia larger than a credit card
- NO leggings, sweatpants, trainers, yoga, cargo, denim, spandex, or lycra

INDOOR COLD WEATHER GEAR



- TYPE: Hoodie, Jacket, or Sweater
- COLOR: No more than 2 school colors (navy, white, gray, black, and maroon)

- MUST be worn over school approved shirt
- NO prints, plaid, or camouflage
- NO insignia larger than a credit card on outerwear, except for school approved SEHS spirit wear or approved SEHS team affiliated garments
- NO hoods worn in the building
- Cold weather gear that does not meet the description above must be removed upon entering the building.

Hoodie, Jacket, or Sweater COLOR: No more than 2 school colors (navy, white, gray, black, and maroon)

ACCESSORIES



- SHOES: Closed toe and closed back
- SOCKS: Must be matching and no more than 2 colors with no patterns
- TIGHTS: Must be solid school colors
- BELTS: Must be solid, plain style with no metal, jewels, or ornate buckles

EXCEPTIONS





- FRIDAY SHIRTS: SEHS Club/Activity shirts may be worn ON FRIDAY ONLY!
- CAREER ACADEMY: Must comply with ECCA Dress Code
- WORK BASED LEARNING: Must comply with WBL Guidelines. Lanyards must be worn in the building.
- DUAL ENROLLMENT: Students who attend any classes at SEHS must be in uniform while in the building.

MISC.
