Earlier this month, we hosted a virtual community session to discuss a string of violence-related

behaviors experienced at the high school. More than 600 parents/guardians and staff attended the March 7th virtual community session and shared common concerns, frustrations and outrage. We heard your concerns and acknowledge that we must continue to put safeguards in place for our school environment. The Superintendent introduced new measures designed to reestablish behavioral expectations at our schools, teach our students appropriate behaviors and impose the strictest disciplinary measures for any student who engages in violence, assault, threatens violence, and/or uses technology with the intent to hurt others.
