

MONDAY: Snacks & Facts: The first 100 students attending school will earn a snack with a Mental Health (MH) fact attached.


TUESDAY: A Licensed Therapist, Andres Waters, will come and speak to a select group of students per grade. Students will be selected by staff.

THURSDAY: The "I Wish" Station is an opportunity where students can share their views and opinions on what programs/services would be effective for young and older men today. Students will have an opportunity to record their thoughts and place them in a box anonymously!

FRIDAY: "Gloves Over Guns" presentation and demonstration with a select group of 30 students. Dress Down Day for those who completed the survey by Wednesday, May 17th and who received a wristband.

Dismissal and Community Horseplaying

As the weather changes and our 6th and new 7th grade students get comfortable traveling home by themselves. Please have conversations with your warriors about how they conduct themselves in the community and traveling home. Neighbors have reached out about students horseplaying in the community and being boisterous and using profane language. These behaviors are not indicative of Boys' Latin Warriors. Please have conversations with your Warrior about who they are traveling home with and about being true to themselves and not following the crowd.

PLEASE NOTE while students are traveling home or coming to school, and they are engaging in behaviors that violate our code of conduct they will still receive school consequences.

Technology Updates

- 1. All students and families must submit all technology related(laptop, passwords, chargers login information) issues/ requests to support@boyslatin.org.
- 2. In-Person technology support is available to students during their lunch period on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Out IT specialist is available to middle school students on the stage in the dining hall during each lunch period.
- 3. All students and their parents have received the *One-to-One Laptop Program Policy* and signed the *One-to-One Laptop Program Agreement*. This means all students and their parents are accountable to the policy. Students must report damage, issues, and concerns related to their school-issued device (Chromebook and Chromebook charger) to the Technology Department within one school day. Damage due to negligence as well as loss or theft of a school-issued device is the responsibility of the student and their parent. The fee for a lost or stolen Chromebook is \$300.00 and the fee for a lost or stolen Chromebook charger is \$45.00. In the event a school-issued device is stolen, if the student or parent report of the incident is deemed credible, the school will replace the device at no charge to the student or parent. Damage due to negligence or loss of a school-issued device are level two or level three violations of the school's *Code of Conduct*



The Man Box

Please join us in helping dismantle the Man Box and redefining what manhood is. To learn more about the Man Box please check out this video and website A Call to Men

Each report period, each grade will focus on dismantling a stereotype in the man box and focus on exemplifying the behaviors that boys/men should exemplify.



Represents how boys and male-identified people are taught to view manhood, women, and girls.

INSIDE THE MAN BOX:

- Women and girls are objects, the property of men, and have less value than men
- Boys and men should not cry or openly express emotion
- · Boys and men should not show fear or weakness
- Boys and men should not "act like a girl"
- Boys and men should be decisive and not ask for, offer, or accept help
- Aggression equals dominance

Using PowerSchool and Kickboard

- 1. Please be sure to check your students' grades on PowerSchool to see any assignments they need to make-up. We recommend doing this on a weekly basis as teachers update grades every week.
- 2. Please check Kickboard to see how your student is being celebrated or corrected throughout the week. When students receive 6 corrective behaviors in one week a student will receive a detention

Quick Ways to Support Your Warrior

1. Locker Support

Many of our warriors need practice opening their lockers. Please have your warrior practice opening a combination lock by using the following link <u>Combination Lock</u> <u>Practice</u>. You can practice directly on a cell phone.

2. Laptop Charging Please make sure your warriors' laptop is charged each night and they bring it to school everyday. 3. Make sure your warrior brings their ID every morning for attendance purposes. If your warrior did not get their picture taken or lost their ID they can see our IT specialist on Tuesday and Thursday during their lunch period. Student **Arriving on Time Attendance** Students are late if they arrive after **7:59AM**. It is imperative that students arrive before and Early 8AM so they can get to class on time. If students arrive after 7:59 they must enter Dismissal through the Visitor Main Entrance. You can always see your students' attendance on PowerSchool. **Early Dismissals** Students are **NOT** allowed to be dismissed by phone or email. Only a parent or an emergency contact can pick-up a student for an early dismissal. All early dismissals must occur before 2:30PM. Dismissal Please do not double park your car on Callowhill Street. It has caused a very dangerous situation for our students who are walking home and catching public transportation. We also want to respect neighbors and neighborhood traffic flow. We understand that parking is limited, but please **DO NOT** double park. **Boys' Latin** Extended Family Network at the middle school. Extended Family Network is like a **Extended** home and school association. Together we can build a framework for the future and **Family** promote mutual understanding, cooperation, and communication among families, Network teachers, and administrators. We can build a school culture that allows for special events, celebrations, and a strong support network.
