

A special meeting of the Board of Education of the Oak Park and River Forest High School was held on Saturday, December 2, 2006, in the boardroom of the Park National Bank, 6011 North Avenue, Oak Park, IL.

Call to Order

President Greenwald called the meeting to order at 8:12 a.m. A roll call vote indicated that the following members were present: Jacques A. Conway, Barbara P. Fernandez, Valerie J. Fisher, Dr. Barry S. Greenwald, Dr. Dietra D. Millard, Yasmin A. Ranney and John P. Rigas. Also present was Dr. Susan J. Bridge, Superintendent/Principal. .

Closed Session

Mr. Rigas moved to enter closed session at 8:15 a.m. on Saturday, December 2, 2006, for the purpose of discussing student disciplinary cases 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(10); the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees of the District or legal counsel for the District, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee or against legal counsel for the District to determine its validity 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(2); seconded by Ms. Fernandez. A roll call vote resulted in all ayes. Motion carried.

The Board of Education resumed its open session at 3:20 p.m.

Student Discipline

Ms. Fisher moved to expel student EXP 12/02/06-17 as of December 2, 2006, for the remainder of the 2006-07 school year through the first semester of the 2007-08 school year but to hold the expulsion in abeyance contingent upon the student being a senior and having earned thirty-seven (37) credits and presently enrolled in six classes, completion of regular attendance at an alternative school as necessary, at discretion of the Superintendent/Principal, the waiving of the Fine Arts requirement, and the student's prohibition from participating in the commencement ceremony, prom and all other senior activities; seconded by Ms. Ranney. A roll call vote resulted in all ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. Ranney moved to expel student EXP 12/02/06-18, as of December 2, 2006 for the remainder of the 2006-07 school year and summer school but to hold the expulsion in abeyance contingent upon completion of enrollment and regular attendance at an alternative school for the remainder of the 2006-07 school year, ongoing counseling, and verification and maintenance of

residency in the District; seconded by Ms. Fernandez. A roll call vote resulted in all ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. Ranney moved to adjourn the Special Board Meeting at 3:28 p.m. on Saturday, December 2, 2006; seconded by Mr. Conway. A roll call vote resulted in all ayes. Motion carried.
