

## DAHS 1:1 Initiative 2012-13

In the 1:1 Initiative, all sophomore and junior students at DAHS will be issued a netbook/laptop to be used for academic purposes throughout the school year. Students will be permitted to take their device home, and use it as the classroom teachers see fit during the school day.

Provided this form is signed and returned starting **August 28, 2012** students will be permitted to take their device home with them on a daily basis once they have been issued. Students who return a signed form without a parent signature will be limited to device use during the school day. In these situations, students will be required to pick up and drop off their device at the library on a daily basis.

Any student violating the student handbook regarding Acceptable Use Policy or the following rules will have their privileges revoked immediately for a time period determined by the David Anderson High School principal.

- Students must keep their device in the protective case provided whenever not in use.
- Students must ensure that their lockers are locked whenever storing their device.
- Students are not permitted to allow others to use their device.
- Students may not alter any system configuration or setting except wireless/LAN connections while at home.
- Students are not permitted to download and/or install software without written permission from school personnel.
- Students are only permitted to download podcasts using iTunes that are school appropriate and related to school assignments.
- Students are only permitted to use school and home internet access. Students are not permitted to use free Wi-Fi hotspots (commercial or otherwise).
- Students must follow all guidelines set forth by their classroom teachers.
- Students may personalize using the system provisions only (screensavers and wallpaper that come with the device); students may not personalize carry case and/or device covers.
- Students may use their own wireless mouse/keyboard.

Please note: The school district reserves the right to monitor any and all use of district technology. This includes student usage, documents, visited websites, etc. on the devices. Although a content filter is utilized on the devices, students may be able to access various websites while on a home or business network. Please discuss responsible and appropriate internet usage with your child.
