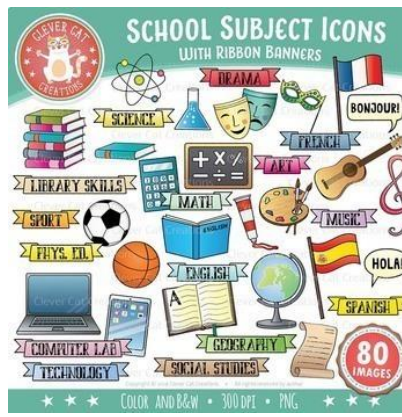


What are your plans after high school? If going to college, what college (if you know) and what do you want to study there?
