

Grading and Transcripts

MCHS students are normally enrolled in six courses per semester. Transcripts are electronically generated using the common 0.00-4.00 GPA. Transcripts include multiple GPAs including 9-12 weighted, unweighted, and Cal Grant. Courses or "AP" are weighted one extra designated "honors" grade point for the grades above "D" for district calculations. Sub GPAs are for the semester indicated. State GPA is an overall GPA excluding physical education class grades.




