Located one hour north of San Francisco, Santa Rosa is a city of 174,170 and is the county seat of Sonoma, with a population of 495,025.

IB World School since 1995, accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, and in 1990 MHS received the California Distinguished School Award

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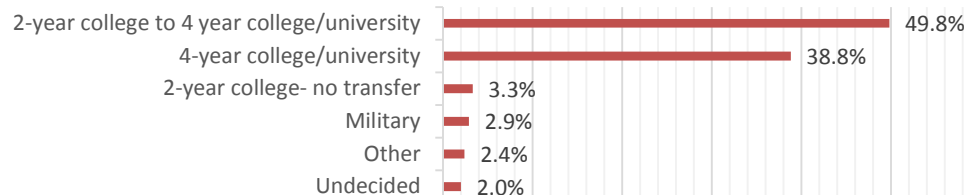
Montgomery High School has more than 1627 students in grades 9 through 12, with a senior class of 382 graduates in the class of 2015.

Montgomery High School reflects the diverse ethnic, cultural, and demographic community of Santa Rosa and the surrounding communities. At least 12% of Montgomery High School students speak a primary language other than English. About 35% of Montgomery High School students qualify for free or reduced lunch.

The Montgomery High School curriculum provides a wide range of rigorous courses, including AVID, Advanced Placement, and International Baccalaureate classes. The school's IB Diploma Program, now over 20 years old, draws students from across the county to Montgomery.

There are more than 100 college preparatory classes available to students, as well as diverse course offerings, including an extensive performing and visual arts curriculum and ROP courses in entrepreneurship, video production and technology, 3-D Animation, and Green Internships. All course work and activities at Montgomery support the schoolwide goal of having every student be successful in a rigorous academic curriculum.

In 2015 scholarship and grant awards approached \$1,000,000.00.

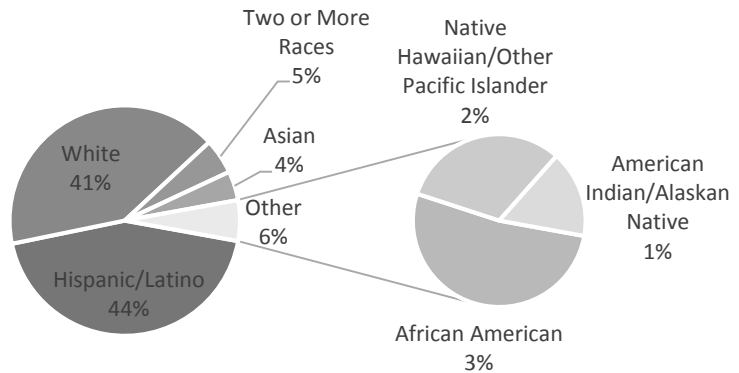
