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Montgomery High School has more than 1700 students in grades 9 through 12, with a senior class of 417 students in the class of 2013.

Montgomery High School reflects the diverse ethnic, cultural, and demographic community of Santa Rosa and the surrounding communities. At least 10% of Montgomery High School students speak a primary language other than English. About 35% of Montgomery High School students qualify for free or reduced lunch.

The Montgomery High School curriculum provides a wide range of rigorous courses, including AVID, Advanced Placement, and International Baccalaureate classes. The school's IB Diploma Programme, now over 19 years old, draws students from across the county to Montgomery.

There are more than 100 college preparatory classes available to students, as well as diverse course offerings, including an extensive performing and visual arts curriculum and ROP courses in entrepreneurship, video production and technology, 3-D Animation, and Green Internships. All course work and activities at Montgomery support the schoolwide goal of having every student be successful in a rigorous academic curriculum.

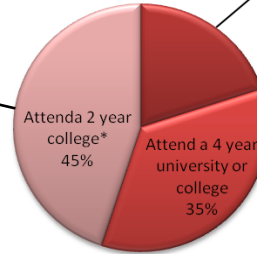
