

## MHS PE Dress Policy

Students will dress in

- PE uniform;
- MHS issued shirt and shorts;
- MHS spirit wear;
- Plain grey crew neck shirt and plain black shorts with a minimum inseam of 5 inches;
- This also translates to outwear (sweats and jackets)

Students that are appropriately dressed will be eligible to receive full credit based on full participation and fulfillment of PE standards

Students that are not appropriately dressed but are dressed for safe athletic activity, may earn up to 65% based on full participation.

Yearly PE uniform rentals are available to all students at no charge, provided the clothes are returned in acceptable condition at the end of the year. This is initiated via Physical Education Rental Agreement, ask your teacher for the paper.

Students who refuse to dress appropriately for PE and who are not safe to participate in their street clothing will be given a written PE alternative and will be eligible to receive up to 65% of the daily credit upon successful completion.

Students that do not comply with the clear expectations above will receive:

- 1<sup>st</sup> suit cut/non compliant: referral to student advisor with parental notification and either a lunch restriction or after school detention
- 2<sup>nd</sup> suit cut/non compliant: Referral to assistant Principal with parental notification, and multiple lunch restrictions and/or after school detentions
- 3<sup>rd</sup> suit cut/non compliant: Referral to assistant Principal with Parent/Student/Teacher/Admin conference
- 4<sup>th</sup> suit cut/non compliant: out of class suspension
